

MARA REPEATER NEWS

The M.A.R.A. Repeater is connected to the West Michigan Connect Repeater System. While the repeater continues to be available in the FM Analog mode when there is not a C4FM conversation in play.

Since 2016, the MARA net's time was shifted to a starting time of 7:30 pm every Thursday evening on the MARA repeater.

Every third Thursday of the month, the Net will operate Simplex on the output Frequency of 145.230 Mhz. No PL tone is needed. This is being done to test the emergency preparedness in the advent of a power failure and the emergency battery source runs out of energy.

The MARA Net Director is Joe Januszka, W8JPJ. Joe is currently recruiting Net Control Operators. Contact Joe as Net Director on W8USA,ORG.

Immediately following the net is an Informal 6 Meter AM net on 50.4 Mhz. Please check your mode to be sure you are on AM before checking in. The 6 Meter net also meets on Sunday Mornings at 8 am, and many Holidays at 8 am as well.

And try to jinn us on our new 440 Mhz Repeater on 444.450 Mhz, Analog or Digital. This repeater is located on the NE ide of Grand Rapids near 5 mile Road and Plainfield. You will find several club members on at 11 am daily when we host an informal "get together" on this repeater.

Several members do monitor the 440 machine and you can faind us by giving a call on both Digital (Fusion) and analog modes. We are looking forward to hearing you on either repeater.
