First on the agenda, after removing the tri-bander, was to play forest ranger to remove parts of two trees and remove a bush at the base of the tower. No matter how mild the breeze was, the Mosley proved to be a very efficient "Wind Catcher" and pulled itself away from the Mast and rotates vertical no matter how Corey tried. The task was finally accomplished with the addition of Corey's son-in -law to climb up and secure the beam.


